DV4/MT4: Creating a PACKAGE of pages using a USB storage device.

Description

Using the Package from Pages feature enables the creation of packages that can be shared between devices that have the same symbol sets. When multiple pages or popups are grouped into a package, they can be shared without having to select each of the individual page files.

Resolution

To create a package of communication pages and/or popups to a USB storage device, follow these steps:

Note: It is strongly recommended to perform a soft reset prior to creating a package. For more information on performing a soft reset, [click here](#).

1. Plug the USB storage device into the USB host port on the right side of your DV4/MT4 device.
2. Select the pull-down menu button in the title bar at the top of the touch screen.
3. Select **Setup**.
4. Select **Tools Menu**.
5. Select the **Page Browser**.
6. In the right viewport, select the check box beside the name of any page or popup to included in the package.
 - **Note:** To select all pages within the folder, select the **Select All** checkbox.
7. Select the **Sharing Operations** button. The Sharing Operations menu will open.
8. Select the **Package from Pages** button.
9. Select the **Show All Directories** check box.
10. Select the **UMS_FOLDER** folder in the left viewport.
 - **Note:** If you are creating a package on the page editing software, select the drive letter that represents your USB storage device (typically E: or F:).
11. Select the **Name** text box. A system keyboard popup will open.
12. Enter a name for the new package.
13. Select the **OK** button to close the system keyboard popup.
14. Select the **OK** button when the package has been successfully created.
15. Select the **OK** button to close the Page Browser menu.
16. Select the **OK** button to close the Tools menu.
17. You may remove the USB storage device if desired.

The new package can now be found on the USB storage device.
